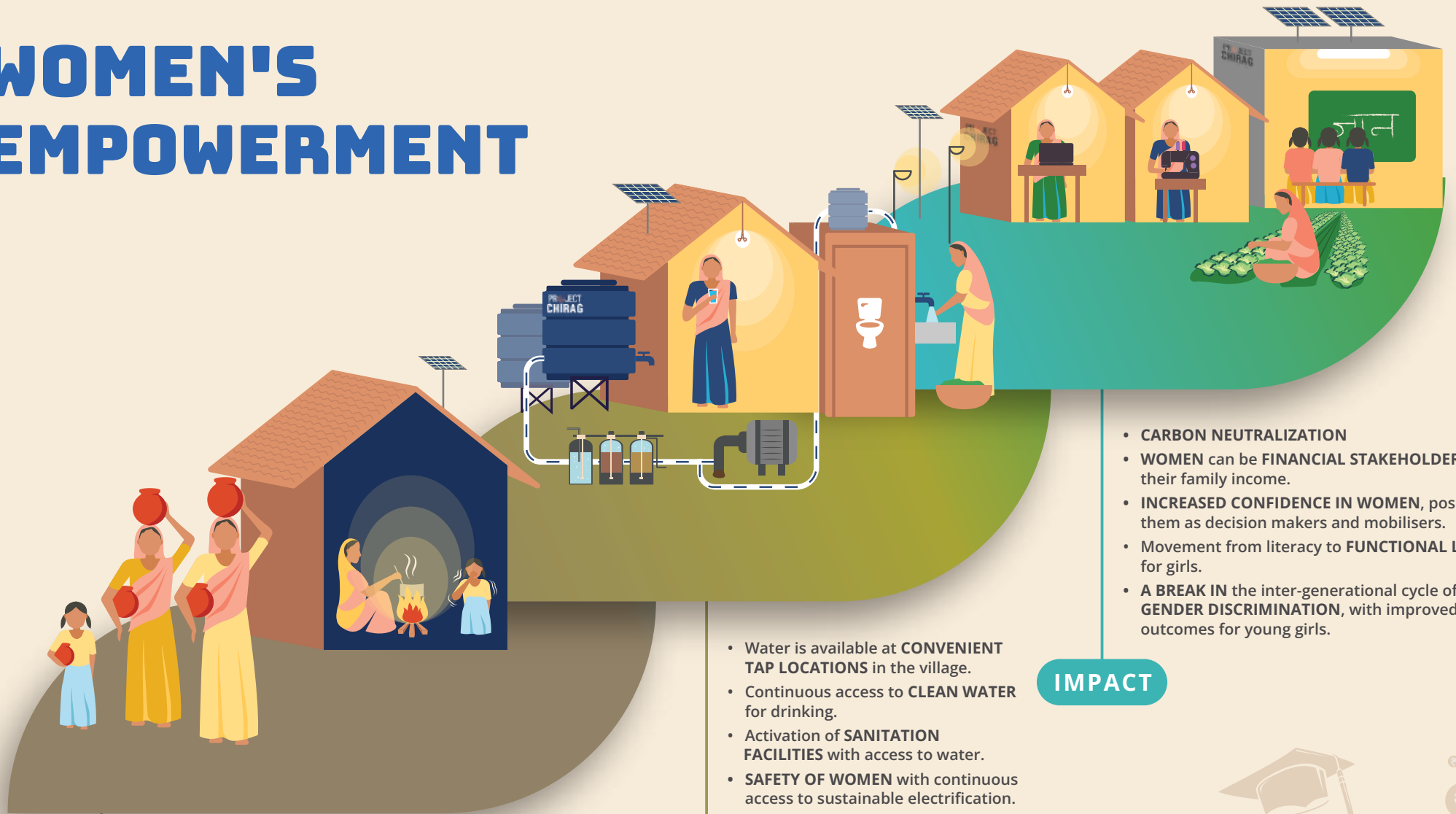


# WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT



## CHALLENGES

- **DISPARITY** in women's **LITERACY**.
- **GENDER DISCRIMINATION**.
- **LACK OF EDUCATION** for girls.
- **POOR SAFETY** and security.
- **FINANCIAL DEPENDENCY** of women.
- **POOR HEALTH** indicators.

## OUTPUTS

- Water is available at **CONVENIENT TAP LOCATIONS** in the village.
- Continuous access to **CLEAN WATER** for drinking.
- Activation of **SANITATION FACILITIES** with access to water.
- **SAFETY OF WOMEN** with continuous access to sustainable electrification.
- **INCREASED PRODUCTIVITY** of women outside the home.
- **IMPROVED ATTENDANCE** of girl child in school.
- Women have opportunities for **SKILLING AND LIVELIHOOD**.

## IMPACT

- **CARBON NEUTRALIZATION**
- **WOMEN** can be **FINANCIAL STAKEHOLDERS** in their family income.
- **INCREASED CONFIDENCE IN WOMEN**, positioning them as decision makers and mobilisers.
- Movement from literacy to **FUNCTIONAL LITERACY** for girls.
- **A BREAK IN** the inter-generational cycle of **GENDER DISCRIMINATION**, with improved future outcomes for young girls.
